


Log on to Yahoo website: www.yahoo.com

Capitalization matters. Use 6 to 32 characters, no spaces, and don't use your name or Yahoo! ID.

Re-type Password

To make your password more secure:

- Use letters and numbers
- Use special characters (e.g., @)
- Mix lower and uppercase

Prepare a password with at least 6 characters and type it in the Password box then retype your password. (MAKE A NOTE OF YOUR PASSWORD). *Please note that when typing your password in the password box, you will only see black dots.* Please be very careful when typing and retyping your password.
